

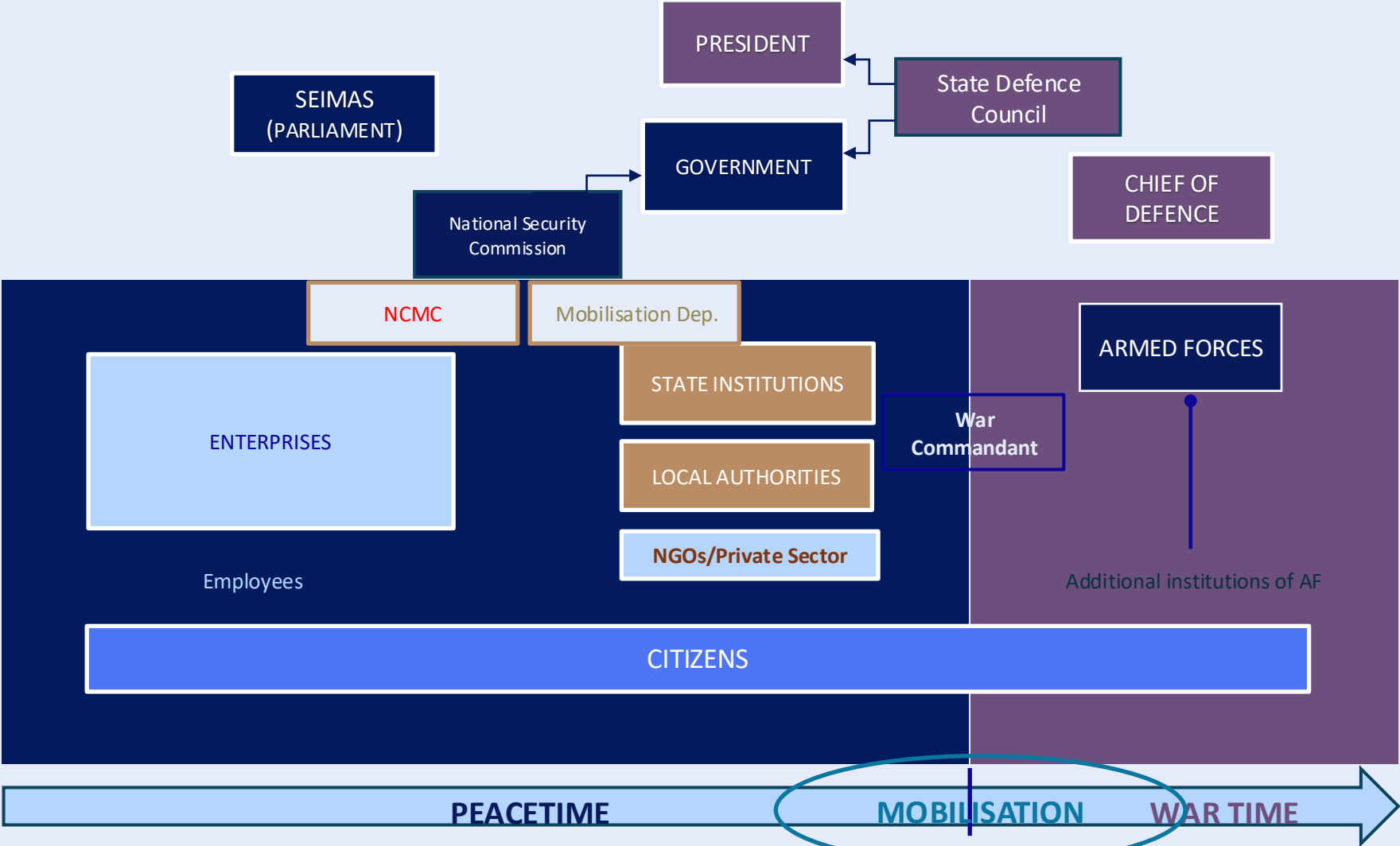

Coordination of national strategic communication

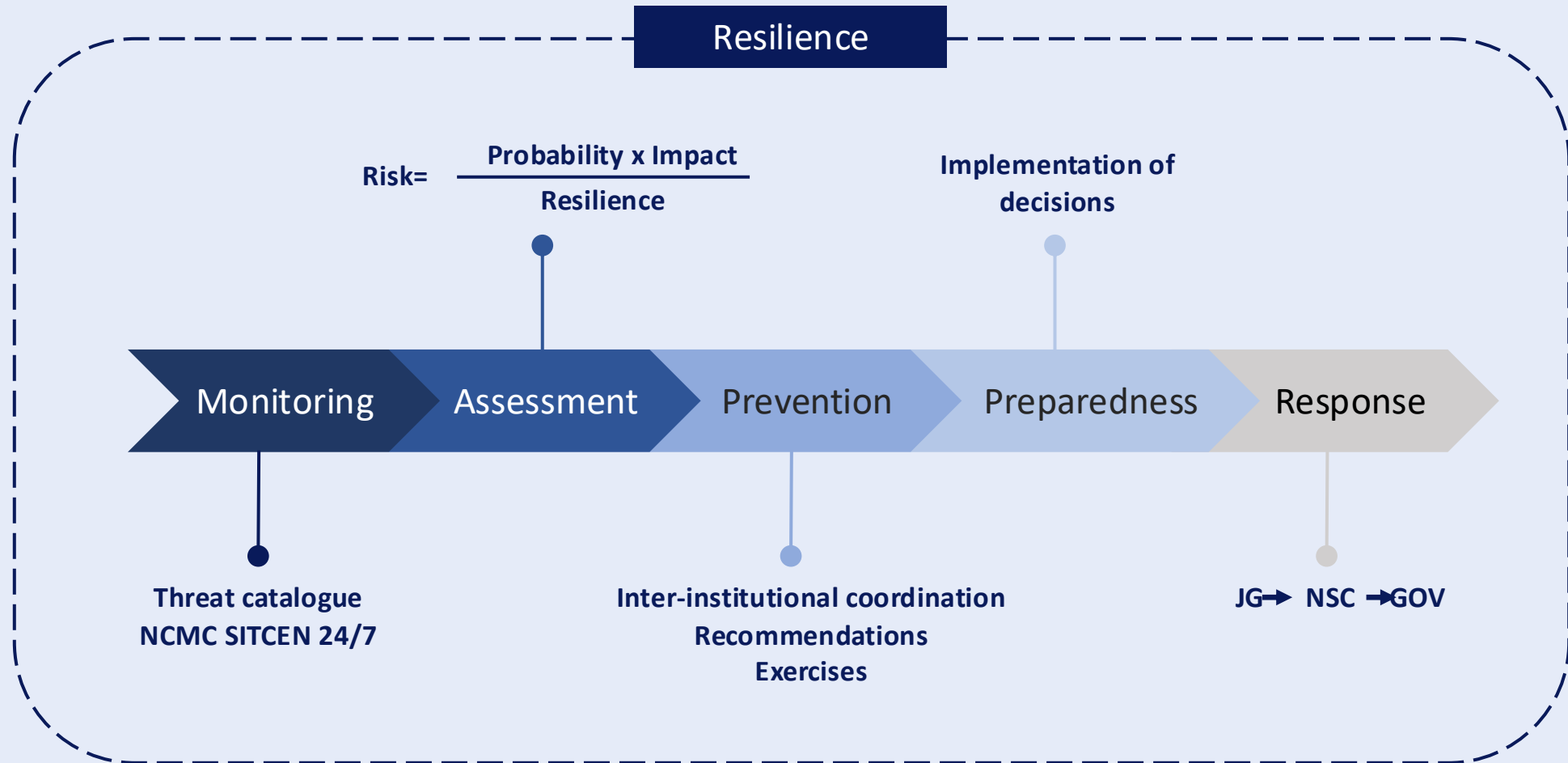

Coordination of the national mobilisation of NGOs, volunteer forces



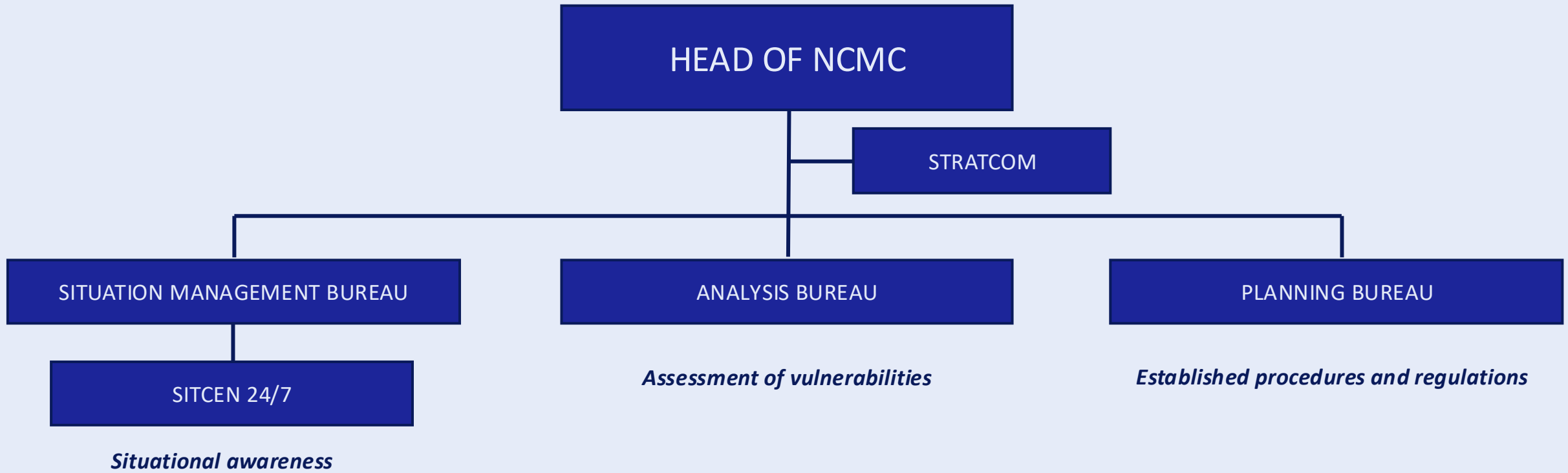
Threat monitoring, assessment and warning system



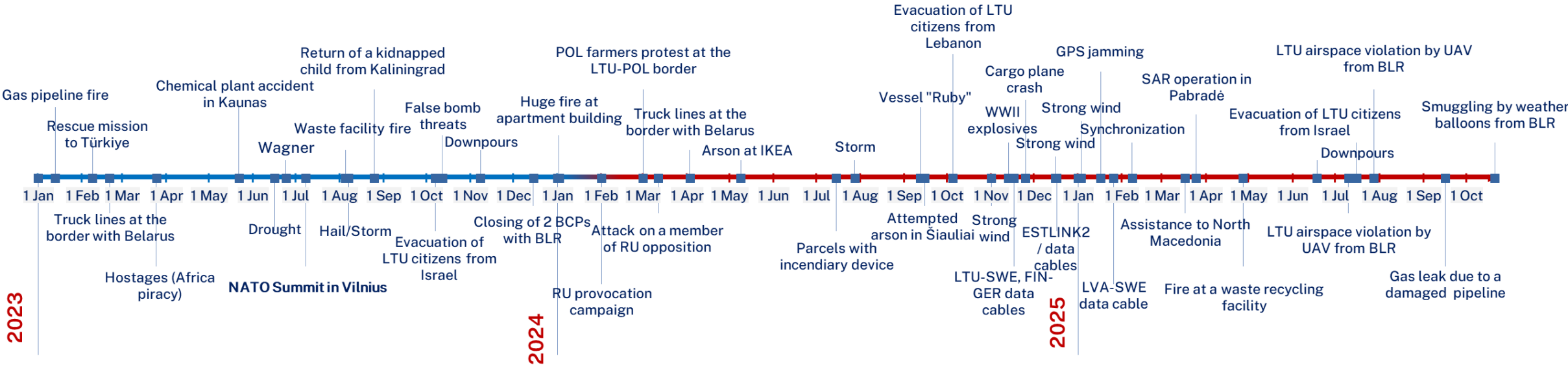
Decision-making algorithm



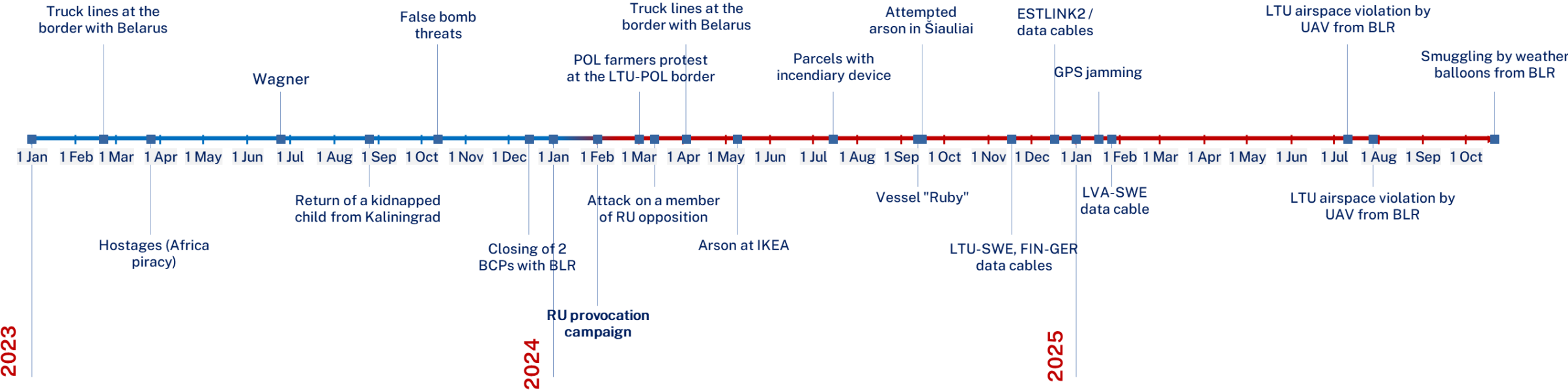
NCMC structure



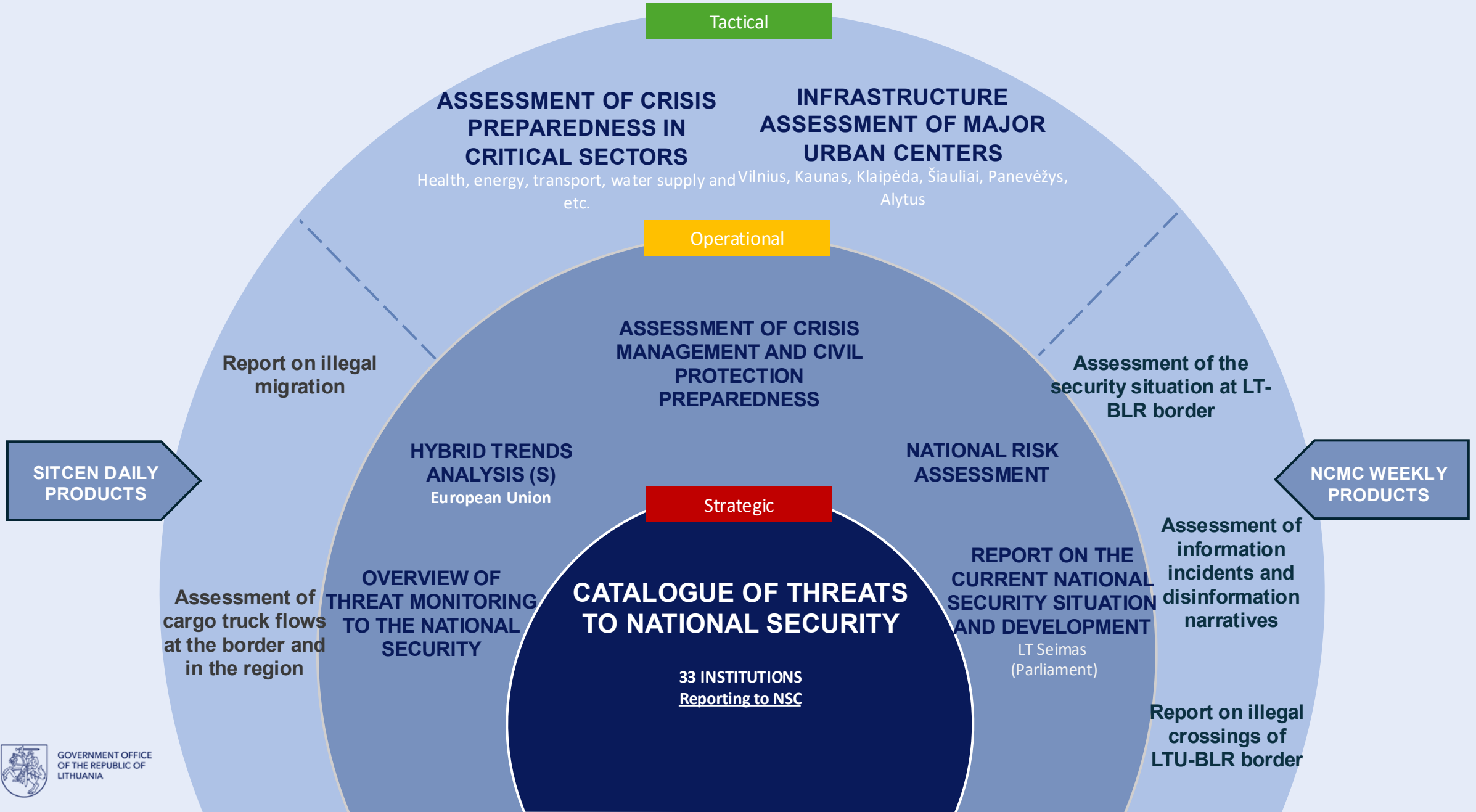
Operations since 2023



Operations since 2023: hybrid incidents

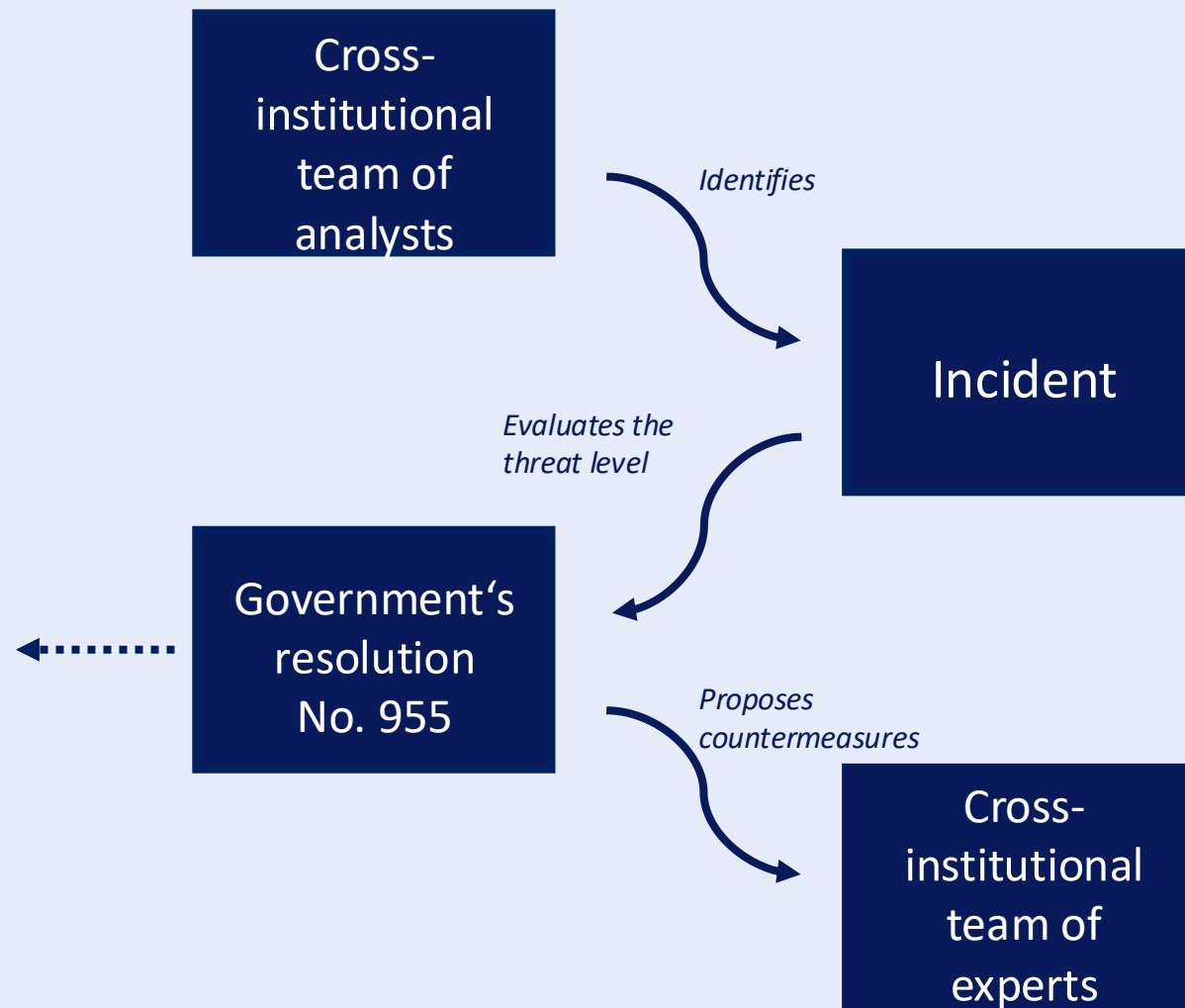


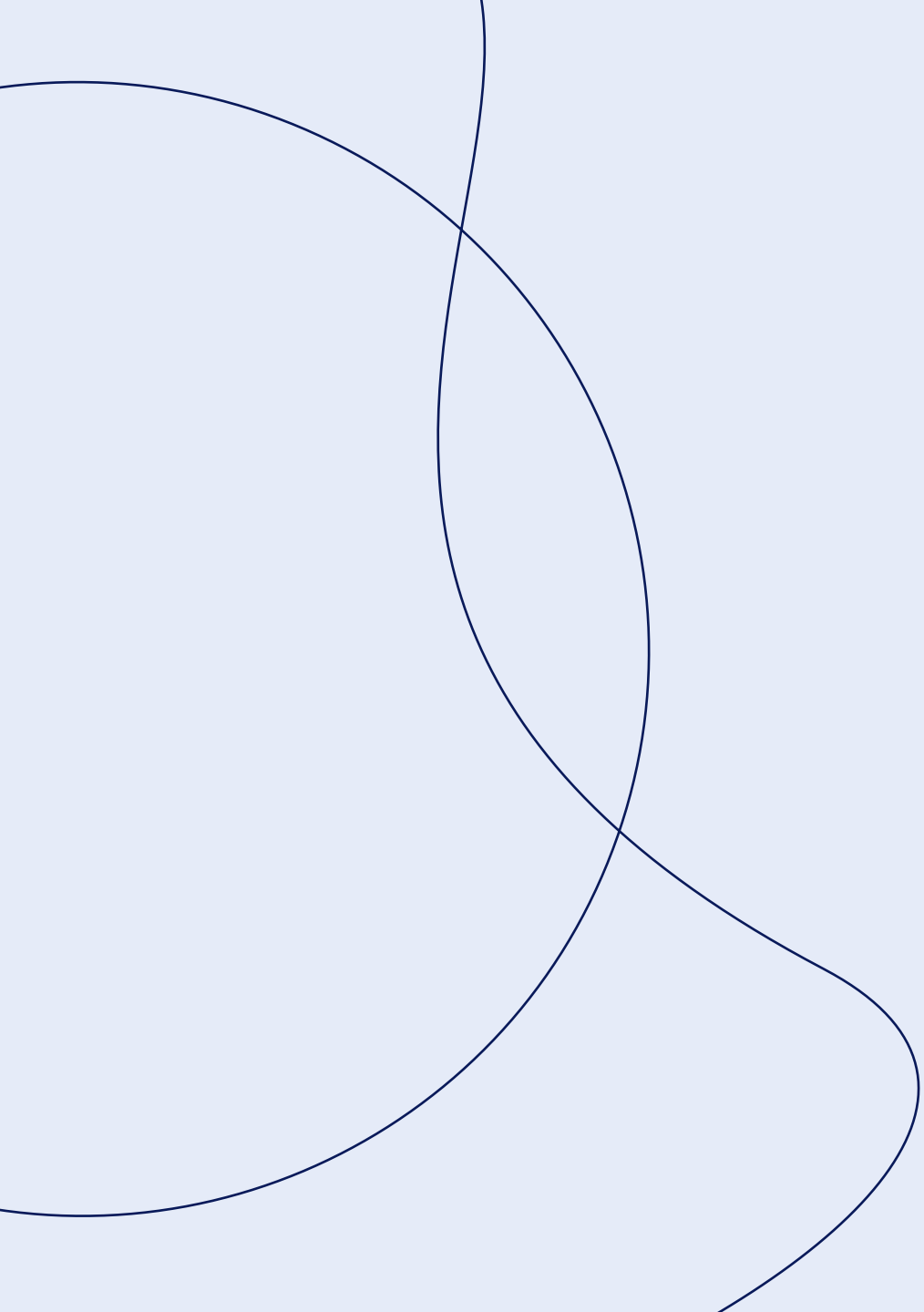
Threat monitoring, assessment and warning system



Assessment of information incidents and response to them

- **First level (9-10 points)**
Level of response: Prime Minister, Government members
- **Second level (6-8 points)**
Level of response: state institutions, organizations
- **Third level (3-5 points)**
Level of response: public information disseminators, NGOs, higher education institutions, other entities shaping public opinion
- **Fourth level (0-2 points)**
Level of response: no response through mass media
